

Otherwise, Wilbur Ellis Company must make appropriate corrections/additions to the study within 30 days following notification by the Agency. If the submitted study is deficient such that another study must be submitted, that study must be submitted within one year from the date of notification by the Agency.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If swallowed:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician. **If inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.

Note to physician: Atropine is antidotal for acetylcholine poisoning. Give 2 mg of atropine intramuscularly or subcutaneously and repeat if symptoms of poisoning persist. Pralidoxime (P-25 or P-2AM) may also be given if available. One gram intramuscularly or intravenously and repeat as necessary.
