SUBJECT: Mancozeb Potato Seed Protectant EPA Registration Number 2935-496 Your Submission of June 5, 2003

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section (3) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable provided you make the following changes:

Ingredient Statement:

Change "maganese" to "manganese".

First Aid Statements:

Delete the phrase "Only for sale to, use and storage by agricultural and service persons."

Precautionary Statements:

Replace the existing precautionary statements with: "Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

Personal Protective Equipment and Agricultural Use Requirements Box:

Replace "waterproof gloves" with "chemical-resistant gloves made out of any water proof material" in the PPE statement and the Agricultural Use Requirements box.

Directions for Use - General Information:

Delete this heading and the statement "Mancozeb Seed Protectant is a unique and enhanced Douglas fir bark based formulation for application on whole or cut potato tubers to aid in the control of Fusarium Seed-Piece Decay." This statement is unacceptable because the basic formulation does not contain Douglas fir and Douglas fir is one of three carriers and is not the major component in the formulation. You cannot selectively identify inert ingredients not present in all formulations of a product although you may identify all inert ingredients in the ingredient statement.

Storage and Disposal:

- Delete the word "Prohibitions".
- Add the heading and text: "Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry place. Avoid contact with the floor and with moisture."

Although the Agency staff appreciates your use of larger font for this submission than for the previous stamped label dated April 17, 1997, future labels will not be accepted for review unless you use ten point font or larger.

Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

POTATOES: Mancozeb Potato Seed Protectant Fungicide is a special fungicide formulation for application on whole or cut potato tubers to aid in the control of Fusarium Seed-Piece Decay.

Use 1 lb. Mancozeb Potato Seed Protectant Fungicide per 100 lbs of whole or cut potato seedpieces. Apply so that the entire surface of the seed-piece is thoroughly covered by the fungicide. To avoid the breakdown of seed-pieces, treat just prior to planting.

DO NOT USE TREATED SEED POTATOES FOR FOOD OR FEED PURPOSES.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.
