PRODUCT INFORMATION

GRANOX Plus is a special seed treatment formulation of maneb and thiabendazole fungicides which, when used at the correct dosage rate, protects wheat against the seed-borne disease Stinking Smut (Bunt). It also protects wheat crops against certain seed and soll-borne disease causing Root Rot and Seedling Blight. GRANDX Plus is specially designed for on-the-farm treat-ment for drill or planter box application. This application is mixed directly with the seed in the box as it is running into the box or by spreading the treatment over leveled seed and thoroughly mixing the treatment. Refer to application instructions on this label.

Mix thorough with an axe handle or paddle (an axe handle or paddle used for seed treatment purposes only then fill the box with seed and sprinkle the remaining one-half of the powder over the seed ar thoroughly mix until all streaking of the powder has disappeared and coloring of the seed appear to be uniform.

VACUUM PLANTERS: Pour 50 pounds of seed into the planter box. Pour enough GRANOX PLUS on top of the seed to treat 50 pounds or seed. Mix thoroughly with an axe handle or paddle until seed is uniformly covered. Then add any plantability additive at the recommended rate to improve the seed flowability (talc etc.). Mix thoroughly once more with a paddle or axe handle to get uniform coverage. This process will provide the best seed flow through the planter while providing all the benefits of the seed treatment product.
