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- b. Under item "B" of the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" change "CAUTION" to "NOTICE" so as to remove any potential for confusion between the use of "CAUTION" there and the label's required signal words "DANGER POISON".
  - c. Change "should" to "must" in the second paragraph of the "USE RESTRICTIONS" portion of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" and expand the paragraph to read as indicated below.

"Bait must be applied directly into pocket gophers' underground burrow systems. Do not apply bait above ground. Do not apply bait over food or feed crops. Do not broadcast bait. Do not apply this bait product by use of a burrow-builder machine."

Because of a 1988 court injunction, no above-ground uses of Strychnine are permitted in the U.S. This product's label must clearly prohibit above-ground uses. As there are no tolerances for Strychnine, the label also must prohibit food or feed uses (which do not include subterranean applications in cropland, rangeland, or pasture areas).

- d. Add the EPA Registration No. 2935-524 to the label.

Note that "USE RESTRICTIONS" and "BAITING" are subsections of the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" section of the label. When labels are printed, make sure that this required relationship would be likely to be obvious to all readers. To do this, you may left-justify the subheadings "USE RESTRICTIONS" and "BAITING" while keeping "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" centered. Alternatively, you may keep the main heading and subheadings centered if a larger and bolder type face is used for "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" than is used for "USE RESTRICTIONS" and "BAITING". As only one method of baiting is permitted by this label, the "subsubheading" "HAND BAITING" is not necessary. Note that on the label of your 2935-508 product, it remains necessary to clearly distinguish directions for manual applications from those for burrow-builder treatments.

Note that optional elements on labels such as disclaimers, logos, and graphics may not detract from or contradict any element of required labeling.

You will have 18 months from the date of this letter to submit or cite acceptable Storage Stability data (Guideline No. 63-17) for this product. As indicated in the terms of the Strychnine Settlement Agreement of 1989, you must provide quarterly reports of progress toward the meeting this product-specific data requirement. Referencing this product in future progress reports and in the Storage Stability data submission for 2935-508 will be sufficient to meet these requirements, provided that the reports and the data are acceptable.

The proposed Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated March 1, 1995, is acceptable for this product as a repack of 2935-508.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before your release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If you fail to comply with the conditions outlined in this notice, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA §6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY. If less than ten (10) minutes has passed since poison was taken, give 1 to 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep him warm and quiet. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

- A. Administer 100% oxygen by positive pressure to provide as much pulmonary gas exchange as possible despite seizures.
- B. Administer anticonvulsant drugs intravenously to control convulsions. CAUTION: It may be difficult or impossible to stop the seizure activity without stopping respiration. Be prepared to maintain pulmonary ventilation mechanically. Tracheotomy may be necessary if seizures are prolonged.

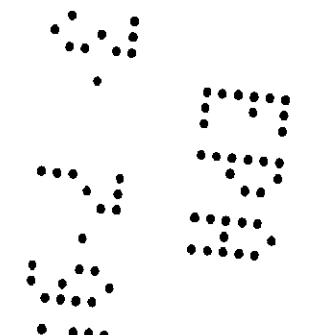

DANGER

Strychnine baits should not be used in the geographic ranges of the following species except under programs and procedures approved by the U.S.EPA: California Condor, San Joaquin Kit Fox, Aleutian Canada Goose, Morro Bay Kangaroo Rat, Gray Wolf, and Grizzly Bear.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

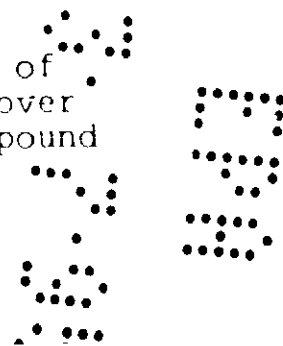
USE RESTRICTIONS

For use on rangeland, pasture, cropland and nonagricultural areas to control the following species of pocket gophers: Northern (Thomomys talpoides); Southern (Thomomys umbrinus); Camas (Thomomys bulbivorus); Valley (Thomomys bottae); Mazama (Thomomys mazama); Plains (Geomys bursarius); Mountain (Thomomys monticola); Townsends' (Thomomys townsendi).

Bait should be applied directly into underground burrow system.

BAITING

HAND BAITING: Remove burrow plug from the flat side of the burrow fan. Use long-handled spoon and insert one teaspoon of bait in to the main runway system. Do not permit soil to cover bait. Depending upon pocket gopher population levels, one pound



of bait applied by hand will treat one to eight acres.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original labeled container, in a cool and dry place inaccessible to children, pets and domestic animals. Do not stock containers more than three high. Do not store directly on concrete floors or concrete walls. Avoid contamination of other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spilled bait or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.
