STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY: If less than ten (10) minutes has passed since poison was taken, give 1 to 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep him warm and quiet. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

A. Administer 100% OXYGEN by positive pressure to provide as much pulmonary gas exchange as possible despite seizures.

B. Administer anticonvulsant drugs intravenously to control convulsions, NOTICE: It may be difficult or impossible to stop the seizure activity without stopping respiration. Be prepared to maintain pulmonary ventilation, mechanically. Tracheotomy may be necessary if selzures are prolonged.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistant with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For use on rangeland, pasture, cropland and nonagricultural areas to control the following species of pocket gophers: Northern (Thomomys talpoides); Southern (Thomomys umbrinus); Camas (Thomomys bulbivorus); Valley (Thomomys bottae); Mazama (Thomomys mazama); Plains (Geomys bursarlus); Mountain (Thomomys monticola); Townsends' (Thomomys townsendi).

Balt must be applied directly into pocket gophers' underground burrow system. Do not apply bait above ground. Do not apply bait to food or feed crops. Do not broadcast balt. Do not apply this bait product by use of a burrow-builder machine.

BAITING: Remove burrow plug from the flat side of the burrow fan. Use long-handled spoon and insert one teaspoon of bait into the main runway system. Do not permit soil to cover bait. Depending upon pocket gopher population levels, one pound of balt applied by hand will treat one to eight acres.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original labeled container, in a cool and dry place inaccessible to children, pets and domestic animals. Do not stock containers more than three high. Do not store directly on concrete floors or concrete walls. Avoid contamination of other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spiffed bait, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label Instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
