AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontaminating, notification and emergency assistance. DRY UP™ is a product containing sulfur and copper oxychloride sulfate, a fixed neutral copper.

Application of material containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

GRAPES: Bunch Rots, Powdery Mildew – Use 20 pounds per acre. Apply at the time berries begin to touch. Repeat at weekly intervals or as needed to maintain control. For disease control the material must be applied before the disease appears.

Concord and other Labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or your State Agricultural Extension Service for additional information consistent with directions on this label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, fold and roll back bags, clamp and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills.

To confine spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.
