DRY UP™ is a product containing sulfur and copper oxychloride sulfate, a fixed neutral copper.

Application of material containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

GRAPES: Bunch Rots, Powdery Mildew – Use 20 pounds per acre. Apply at the time berries begin to touch. Repeat at weekly intervals or as needed to maintain control. For disease control the material must be applied before the disease appears.

Concord and other Labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or your State Agricultural Extension Service for additional information consistent with directions on this label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, fold and roll back bags, clamp and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers.
