The proposed amended label submitted on January 25, 2012, for this product is accepted under the provisions of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. When labels are printed, the changes indicated below should be made to that label.

1. The last two paragraphs in the "**Further Use Instructions**" cell opposite "Grapefruit, Lemons" in the table for "**FOLIAR APPLICATIONS – DILUTE SPRAYS**" (first page, right panel) should read as shown below.

Do not apply more than 159 lbs. of active ingredient or more than 1500 gallons of spray mix per acre in Texas or Florida.

Do not apply more than 212 lbs. of active ingredient or more than 2000 gallons of spray mix per acre in California.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.


Submit two copies of final printed labeling before releasing this product for shipment under the labeling accepted via this letter.
