- Apply uniformly at the recommended rate using a lawn spreader.
   Contents of this bag cover up to 5,000 sq. ft. for moss control or up to 7,500 sq. ft. for fertilization.
- Water thoroughly immediately after application to wash fertilizer particles off grass and down into the soil.
- Sweep or blow off sidewalks, driveways and painted surfaces as ferrous sulfate may stain concrete.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Apply one pass evenly with a properly calibrated drop type or rotary spreader. A two-pass application, crisscrossing the area at half the rate each time is the same as one application. Always apply with fertilizer spreader. Do not apply by hand.

Spreader setting are approximate. The conditions of your spreader, the speed at which you walk and the width between spreader passes may cause differences in the rate of application.
