CONCENTRATE

Insecticide

The windows and doors or the rooms to be sprayed should be closed and kept closed for one half hour after the insecticide has been applied. Do not re-enter treated area. Ventilate the room after treatment is completed. For every 500 cubic feet use 4 ounces of Concentrate 441, direct spray thoroughly on joints, cracks and crevices about the room.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Concentrate 441 is a combination of synergized pyrethrum extract and odorless oil base, giving a superior knock-down and killing power.

SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATIONS for control of roaches in food-processing plants and food and drink vending machines. Sprayings for effective control should be on regular schedules each week. Repeat when necessary. Always spray surfaces sufficiently to wet. If areas are washed or scrubbed, they should be retreated.

TO KILL spiders, centipedes, crickets, wasps, flies, black flies, sand flies, stable flies, horse flies and green bottle flies hit directly with the spray.

NOTE: Picnickers, campers and golfers will find this insecticide of some relief in temporarily repelling flies and mosquitoes. Spray liberally around shoes and various parts of clothing. Spray picnic benches liberally and frequently.

Use CONCENTRATE 441 in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before reusing.

Door seals and window frames should be closed tightly.

DO NOT SPRAY ON FRESH PAINT. If spray gets on paint, wash off immediately. If spray gets on cloth, paper, plastic or vinyl, wash off immediately. If spray gets on skin, wash off immediately. If spray gets in eyes, flush eyes with water and seek medical attention. Allow sprayed area to remain closed for 10 minutes, then sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat when necessary.

To kill SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES & FLEAS. Thoroughly spray clothing or carpet, and interior and exterior of folds. Closets and storage containers should be filled with fine mist and remain closed for 2 hours after spraying. Spray into any cracks or other holes, piles. Repeat every month unless articles are stored in a cool, tight container. To control fleas, floors, baseboards, floor covering, wall cracks and sleeping quarters of animals will need repeated treatment.



CAUTION:

FLAMMABLE. Do not use near fire, spill or store near heat or open flames. Do not spray near or to walls, open flame. Do not smoke while spraying. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.

Do not reuse empty containers or drums. Drums may be reclaimed by a drum reconditioner. Otherwise, destroy drums and other containers by perforating or crushing. Burn or discard in a safe place away from water supplies.
