## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR CATTLE

Apply to the face, neck, and body of the animal. Repeat as needed.

**FOR HORSES.** Apply to the face, neck, and body. Spray the animal thoroughly, using 1 to 2 ounces per animal. Repeat as needed. Give special attention to the ears and belly. Apply to the animal's head but do not spray the eyes. Repeat as needed.

**FOR SWINE.** Spray the animal thoroughly on the face, neck, and body. Repeat as needed.

**FLEAS ON CATS & DOGS:** Spray animal with a fine mist spray. Repeat as needed.
