Vestibule Areas. Apply with compressed air spray or fogging device such as Fogger-Duster-Dye, or directly with sprayer. Effective against insects, rodents, carpet and insecticide. Close all windows, doors, and openings during fogging operation. Keep closed for 10-20 minutes after application. Repeat treatment when necessary. Follow directions and recommendations of equipment manufacturer for proper setting and position of fogging machine. Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place.

Directions For Use

For the control of accessible stages of weevils, flour beetles, meal moth larvae, cadelle, saw-toothed grain beetle, roaches, silverfish, ants, spiders, carpet beetles, cheese and flour mites, flies and flying moths.

As A Surface Spray: for the control of crawling insects listed above, apply directly onto walls, partitions, floors, in cracks, crevices, under skids, equipment, scales, motor mounts, on ledges, in conveyors, proofers, behind switch boxes, sinks, storage cabinets, floor drains, locker and lunch rooms and all places where insects may harbor and multiply. Clean areas thoroughly before spraying. Dust and dirt absorb insecticides which limits effectiveness. Repeat treatment when necessary.
