DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use on structural timbers having square, different end sizes that the girth of a 40' circumference standing pole is taken as a guide and example for application of this product.

For timber, use four or five holes, 12" apart and depth about 2" times the radius of the wood at about 45° angle downward. The first hole should be at the girth and the second hole at about 6" below and 4" inward from the first hole to be.

Do not use amounts of the fumigant in excess of the amount of the fumigant in the label.

Do not use with treated wood. Do not use in areas where food is stored. Do not use in areas where children play.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty containers. Do not use for anything other than the purpose for which they were designed.
