PRODUCT INFORMATION

TimberFume is a fumigant solution. When used as directed, it will arrest internal decay present in Douglas-fir, western red cedar and southern pine poles, pilings and similar to 20 timber members in terrestrial sites. Such treatment has been shown to arrest internal decay up to six years, however, efficacy is expected to vary from one application to another. Timber known to have internal decay should be scheduled for treatment before it has decayed to the point where replacement is necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This fumigant is a highly hazardous material and should be used only by persons trained in its proper use. Before using, read and follow all label precautions and directions.

All persons working with this fumigant should be trained in the hazards, use of required respirator equipment and detector equipment, emergency procedures and proper use of the fumigant.

Do not fumigate with this product when temperature is below 40°F.

For in-place treatment of wood piles, poles and timbers, using special Osmose equipment and prescribed techniques.

For poles, piles and timbers in terrestrial sites:

Large structural timbers have so many different end uses that the groundline area of a 40" circumference standing pole is taken as a guide and example for application of this product.

For interior decay drill an adequate number of holes at a 45° angle downward to a length of approximately 2½ times the radius of the wood. The first hole should be at the groundline and succeeding holes approximately 8-12" higher and 30° rotated from the next lower hole.

Inject equal amounts of fumigant into all holes. The amount of fumigant to be used per pole is based on the pole circumference at the groundline and in accordance with the table below.

Circumference	TimberFume
22-29	¼ Pint
30-35	½ Pint
36-45	1 Pint
47-55	1½ Pint

For other types of structural members drill an adequate number of holes, sufficiently spaced and of sufficient dimensions to allow for proper distribution of product.

Plug holes with treated wood plugs, using the precautions of wearing safety goggles to avoid splashing any of the liquid into the eyes.

For use only by Certified Applicators employed by Osmose or by persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's Certification.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In all cases of overexposure, get medical attention immediately. Take person to a doctor or emergency treatment facility.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Chloropicrin is a volatile liquid that is the active ingredient in tear gas. As a gas, it is a powerful lachrymator. Early symptoms of overexposure are lachrymation, respiratory distress and vomiting. Pulmonary edema may develop later. Treatment is symptomatic.
