**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Dig around the ground line of the pole treated to a depth of approximately 20 inches. Remove hardened creosote and rotted wood. Inspect pole as to remaining serviceability. Measure circumference of the pole to be treated. Measure the surface of the pole to be treated. Measure the circumference of the pole. Cut from the Patox bandage material the length needed to the pole to the depth of approximately 20 inches below ground line, and 2 inches above ground line. Attach to pole by means of stapler. Be sure bandage is pulled tight in line with contact with the wood pole. Backfill with soil to tamp the earth around the pole to 2 inches above the original ground line.

Proper use includes the removal of any exposed wood above the Groundline where children or livestock may come in contact with it. Various products can be used for this purpose are Osmose's Cattle Guard or some other type of which could prevent the insect from being removed and consumed.
