2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

(a) Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 3008-55."

(b) Under Storage and Disposal, change Disposal to "Container Disposal".

3. Submit one-year exposure data at ambient warehouse conditions within 15 months after the date of this registration in order to complete corrosion resistance test requirements.

4. Submit a skin sensitization test before May 24, 1993. Study MRID 424898-01 has been classified Supplementary. Please see the enclosed review for details.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

DESCRIPTION

COP-R-PLASTIC contains recognized salt preservatives used successfully in the art of wood preservation for more than forty (40) years. This combination of sodium fluoride and copper naphthenate provides deep, long lasting protection against decay.

COP-R-PLASTIC is designed for use in ground-line treatment of standing poles, piling and other timber members.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove existing decay as thoroughly as possible. Apply with ordinary stiff bristle brush, bradage or caulking tube in a zone 18" below to 3" above ground, making liberal applications to checks and areas where decay has been removed. Cover entire treated area with our waterproof bandage, Osmoshield, and backfill hole.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

If product is in metal container, do not attempt to burn or incinerate. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:
