DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Only for formulation into an end-use fungicide, for (1) the following uses: groundline treatment of standing poles, piling, and other timber members; pole framing; poles and poletops; piling application; bridge members; and railroad tie repair; (2) uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and (3) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in cool dry area. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
