## General Comments

1. Revise Storage and Disposal section to read as follows:

## Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal

Pesticide Storage: Store in cool dry area

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting ... facility

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag. Then...smoke

2. Revise the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) language to read as follows:

# **Personal Protective Equipment**

Applicators and other handlers must wear.

- coveralls, over long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- socks and chemical resistant foot wear;
- goggles or face shields,

- chemical resistant gloves (such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride, viton). For mixing/loading: Wear a chemical resistant apron.

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product.
