- c. Revise the First Aid Statement to read as follows:

**Description:** FirePRO is an interior wood preservative that requires dilution with water prior to application. It provides fire retardant properties, FirePRO affords protection against decay and white rot), wood boring insects,

**Product Uses:** For application to doors, windows, trim and other engineered and solid wood products. It is used in above ground applications. Wood preservative applications where the material may be exposed to moisture, regular condensation. The treated wood should be kept above ground.

**Wood Preparation:** Machine, cut, g... Wood must be clean and dry before application. Wood should be kiln dried or air seasoned to a moisture content that permit adequate penetration of preservative.

**Treatment:** Contents are for use on wood surfaces utilizing water solutions and having a weight ratio by weight. Pressure treatment recommended as described in the current Osmose FirePRO label. For those described in the American Wood Preservers Institute's AWPA C1-11.

**Finishing:** Under normal temperature and humidity based paints, as well as water- and oil-based finishes, may be treated with FirePRO. If prolonged drying is expected, special surface preparation is required. An appropriate primer are recommended. The surface should be lightly sanded, clean and free of dust. See the coating manufacturer's label instructions.
