DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Use MTZ to control all types of fungal decay of wood products - brown, white and soft rot and wood eating insects. MTZ should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay both above and in ground. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence boards, and posts, building poles, decks, docks, walkways, and wood shingles.

Tank mix MTZ with EPA registered metal or organic fungicides and/or termiticides. Apply the tank mix solution by pressure impregnation. The percent solution to be used should be based on the retention, in Ibs., per cubic foot (pcf), specified by the purchaser and by the treating process used. A maximum retention of 0.10 pcf active is recommended.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:
