- c. Change signal word "DANGER" wherever it appears on the label.
- d. Revise the precautionary statement to read as follows:

"DANGER: Corrosive. Causes skin burns and irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear face shield or safety glasses. Wear coveralls worn over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, chemical-resistant gloves, and, protective eyewear. Use ORD-X450 to control all types of fungal decay of wood products - brown, white and soft rot and wood eating insects. ORD-X450 should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay both above and in ground, or water. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence boards, and posts, building poles, decks, docks, walkways, and wood shingles.

Tank mix ORD-X450 with EPA registered metal or organic fungicides and/or termiticides. Apply the tank mix solution by pressure impregnation. The percent solution to be used should be based on the retention, in lbs., per cubic foot (pcf), specified by the purchaser and by the treating process used. A maximum retention of 0.10 pcf active is recommended.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
