

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes skin burns and irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear face shield or safety glasses. Wear coveralls worn over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, chemical-resistant gloves, and protective eyewear. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers must wear eye protection, rubber gloves and appropriate protective clothing to avoid skin contact.

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Use STZ to control all types of fungal decay of wood products - brown, white and soft rot and wood eating insects. STZ should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay both above and in ground. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence boards, and posts, building poles, decks, docks, walkways, and wood shingles.

Tank mix STZ with EPA registered metal or organic fungicides and/or termiticides. Apply the tank mix solution by pressure impregnation. The percent solution to be used should be based on the retention, in lbs., per cubic foot (pcf), specified by the purchaser and by the treating process used. A maximum retention of 0.10 pcf active is recommended.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these pesticides cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Plastic Container:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or, if allowed by state and local authorities by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Metal Container:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
