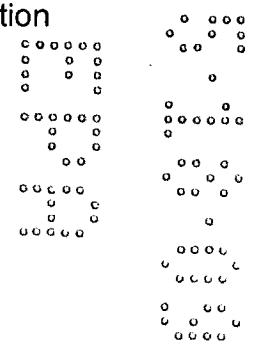

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Use MP200-A to control all types of fungal decay of wood products - brown, white and soft rot and wood eating insects. MP200-A should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay or insect attack both above and in ground, or water. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence boards, and posts, building poles and decks, docks, walkways, and wood shingles.

Dilute MP200-A with water. Apply the tank mix solution by vacuum pressure impregnation with solutions having concentrations ranging from 0.05% - 3.0% active ingredients by weight. The percent solution to be used should be based on the retention, in lbs., per cubic foot (pcf), specified by the purchaser and by the treating process used.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store unused product in original containers in a cool, dry well ventilated area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
