The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

Removing Sodium Nitrite from Formulation

Update label per PR Notice 2007-4

Label Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1.) The "Precautionary Statements" must be revised by first removing the following statement from the "User Safety Recommendations" box and placing them immediately below the signal word, CAUTION, on page 2:

Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

2.) The "User Safety Recommendations" heading and statements must be revised to be incompliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling by stating the following:

User Safety Requirements

Users must wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

Users must remove clothing/PPE immediately, if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Pressure-treating wood products with Sustain[™] 25T provides protection against termites, ascomycetes, white rot, brown rot and dry rot.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Sustain® 25T is only for use in pressure-treating wood products. Apply using vacuum pressure impregnation with water solutions having concentrations ranging from 0.1% - 3.0% active ingredients by weight. Impregnation procedures must rigidly adhere to the current specifications of Osmose, Inc. or the American Wood Protection Association.

The processes used to apply Sustain® 25T formulations must leave no visible surface deposits on the wood. Visible surface deposits indicate a surface residue or crystallization on the treated wood. Small, isolated or infrequent spots of chemical on otherwise clean wood are permitted.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store unused product in original containers only in a cool, well-ventilated location out of the reach of children and animals.
