You must line up the decimal points on the ingredient statement, and,

Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals you must revise the hand washing instructions to read Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating drinking chewing gum using tobacco, or using the toilet

In summary, you have requested an amendment to add two statements
For pressure plant use only Do not spray A stamped copy of the conditionally accepted labeling is enclosed Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling
