Tebuconazole Tech is only for formulation of or repackaging into end-use products intended for use as wood preservatives for above ground and/or in-ground applications. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated product. Wood preservatives containing this product are not for use on wood that will be used to construct beehives.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep product in original container. Do not package this product in metal containers. Store in a cool, dry secure place. Protect from excessive heat.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statement on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Dispose of pesticide as directed below. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.
