

MINT DISINFECTANT

PHENOL COEFFICIENT 5 A.O.A.C METHOD

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

4-chloro-2-phenylphenol 3.20% 0.80% 6-chloro-2-phenylphenol 2.00% Methyl Salicylate 9.90% Isopropanol 6.50% Soap

INERT INGREDIENTS:

Water

77.60% 100.00%

DIRECTIONS FOR USE


GENERAL DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part Disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against the S. Typhosa germ. Apply solution so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing use 15 ounces Disinfectant to each gallon of water in the bucket TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: Wash the closet and urinal bowls regularly with a solution of la ounces of Disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution.

GARBAGE: To aid in preventing the breeding of flies and certain other vermin, sprinkle with the solution in the proportion of la ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

SICKROOM: In the disinfecting of beds, clothes, utensils and rooms, Disinfectant should be used in the proportion of 3 ounces to each gallon of

GENERAL DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part Disinfectant to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against the S. Typhosa germ. Apply solution so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing use 1½ ounces Disinfectant to each gallon of water in the bucket TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: Wash the closet and urinal bowls regularly with a solution of 1½ ounces of Disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution.

GARBAGE: To aid in preventing the breeding of flies and certain other vermin, sprinkle with the solution in the proportion of 13 ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

SICKROOM: In the disinfecting of beds, clothes, utensils and rooms, Disinfectant should be used in the proportion of 3 ounces to each gallon of water.

CUSPIDORS: A solution of $2\frac{1}{2}$ ounces of Disinfectant to a gallon of water will aid in deodorizing and disinfecting cuspidors. Leave this mixture standing in the cuspidors. Always put Disinfectant in the pail first and then add the water.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AVOID CONTACT WITH SKIN AND EYES. DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOOD OR FOODSTUFFS.
