- f. Move the shock hazard statement to the 'Physical or Chemical Hazards' section.

To Control Houseflies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats: Use undiluted or diluted with water as specified below to give desired dilution and apply as a fine mist or fog. Direct spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the room until the area is filled with mist, using about 2 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close doors and windows before spraying, and keep them closed for ten to fifteen minutes after spraying. Vacate the area before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary. Facilities and equipment in federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an effective cleaning compound and rinsed with potable water after spraying.

FOR USE THROUGH AUTOMATIC SPRAYING SYSTEMS:

To Kill Houseflies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats: Add this product to tank undiluted or add water to obtain desired dilution. Agitate well while adding water. Dispense through automatic spraying system. Set nozzles to deliver one 1 ounce liquid per minute. Locate nozzles to cover a maximum of 2,000 cubic feet of space per nozzle. Set time to operate in accordance with equipment directions. Facilities and equipment in federally inspected meat and poultry plants must be washed with an effective cleaning compound and rinsed with potable water after spraying.

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS:

Dilute this product just prior to use as follows:

0.05% Pyrethrins - Add 1 part Concentrate to 1 part water.
