DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply when insects first appear and repeat as necessary. Use the following recommended rates in sufficient water for thorough coverage. (By ground apply a minimum of 10 gallons; by air, a minimum of 5 gallons of finished spray per acre).

ON BROCCOLI, CABBAGE to control Cabbage Looper, Imported Cabbage Worm, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Flea Beetle, Stink Bug use 1½ to 2 quarts per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

ON HEAD LETTUCE to control Cabbage Looper, Green Peach Aphid, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Imported Cabbage Worm, use 1½ to 2 quarts per acre. Do not make more than 3 applications after thinning. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Do not feed crop refuse to livestock. Remove outside leaves at harvest.

ON PEPPERS to control Flea Beetle, Green Peach Aphid, Pepper Maggot and Hornworm use 1 quart per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.


ON COTTON to control Bollworm, Cabbage Looper, Stink Bugs, Lygus Bugs, Cotton Leaf Perforator use 2 quarts per acre. Do not apply after bolls begin to open. For use up to 25% of boll opening use 1 to 1½ quarts per acre. Do not graze meat or dairy animals in treated fields.

ON POTATOES to control Aphids, Armyworms, Potato Tuberworm, Colorado Potato Beetle, Potato Psyllid, Flea Beetle, Stink Bug, Chinch Bugs, Potato Leafhopper use 1 to 2 quarts per acre. Apply at first appearance of insects and repeat as required. No time limitation.

ON TOMATOES to control Aphid, Flea Beetle, Hornworm, Colorado Potato Beetle, Tomato Psyllid, Whitefly use 1 to 2 quarts per acre. To control Stink Bug, Tomato Fruitworm, Cabbage Looper, Armyworm, Tomato Russet Mite use 2 quarts per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.
