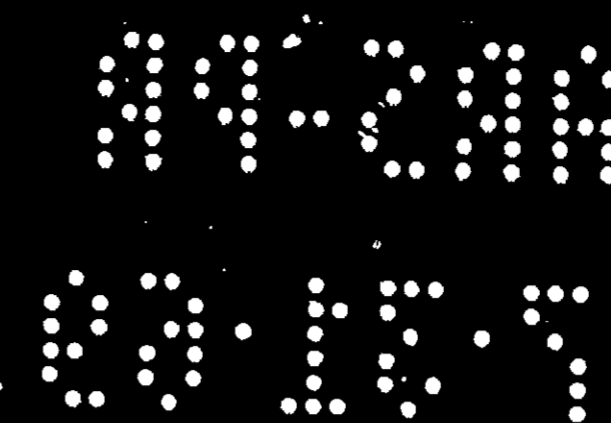

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For general disinfection and cleaning of floors, walls and woodwork, dilute one ounce of SWEPCO DISINFECTANT-DETERGENT in one gallon of warm water. While wearing protective hand covering, thoroughly scrub all surfaces and allow to stand for at least 10 minutes. Rinse with clean water.

For areas suspected of severe contamination or high organic load, dilute two ounces of SWEPCO DISINFECTANT-DETERGENT in one gallon of warm water. Proceed as above.
