Use: A bacteriostatic treatment to inhibit the growth of bacteria, mold and mildew for interior components (cotton felt, sisal hair of furniture, mattresses, carpets, underlays).

WARNING: Keep Out Of Reach Of Children. Causes skin and severe eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Use goggles and protective clothing if sprayed other than with enclosed machinery.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

Directions for Use: Apply 1 gallon of CFC per 1,000 lbs of material. The product is to be used as received and is to be applied by spraying inside an enclosed machine (willow or cone duster). Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on label.
