PREPARATION OF TREATED ARTICLES (FILMS, YARNS & MOLDED PRODUCTS)

- 1. ADD MEASURED QUANTITY OF UNTREATED RESIN TO THE MIXING TANK.

SANITIZED* brand MBP9661 is bacteriostatic agent that is effective against non-health related organisms which may contribute to the deterioration of the treated product. The use of SANITIZED* brand MBP9661 extends the useful life of the treated article & controls deterioration resulting from non-health related organisms on treated articles. Finished products containing SANITIZED* brand MBP9661 may not make claims of antimicrobial activity other than the protection of the article itself against growth of bacteria & mold in or on the treated article.

- Do not use in the manufacture or treatment of items that may come in contact with food.
- Use only under an agreement with Sanitized Inc., New Preston, CT.
- Do not use for the production of baby diapers or fibers for the production of baby diapers.
