On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the I,2-Benzisothiazolin-3-one RED, the EPA has reregistered this product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(q) (2) of the Federal Insecticide. Fungicide and Rodenticide Acts, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. The EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of the subject product.

- b. It is recommended that the phone number for emergency medical treatment ("860-868-9491") be placed with the text "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.
- c. Per the acute toxicity review, the Agency recommends that additional text be added to the Note to Physician that addresses eye irritation concerns.
 - d. Per the acute toxicity review, the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section must be revised to read:

"DANGER

Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled.. Do not breathe vapor or mist spray. Wear coveralls worn over short-sleeved shirt and short pants, socks, chemical-resistant footwear, chemical-resistant gloves made of barrier laminate, butyl, nitrile, or neoprene rubber, polyvinyl chloride or viton, goggles or face shield, and a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any N, R, P or HE prefilter."

e. The Agency recommends that the following User Safety Recommendations Requirements text be added to the label:

"Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."

Discard clothing and other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with this product's concentrate. Do not reuse them."

f. Per the acute toxicity review, the following User Safety Recommendations must be added to the label:

"User Safety Recommendations

User should wash hands before, eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

User should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."

- g. Per the product chemistry review, physical or chemical hazards text must be added to the label.
- h. Per the product chemistry review and PR Notice 2007-4, revisions are needed to the Storage and Disposal section of the label.

- i. Per the Octhilinone RED, add the text "Use only to treat carpet backing. Not for use in carpet fibers."
- j. If intended for use as a plastic preservative, per the Octhilinone RED add "Treated plastics cannot be used to manufacturer children's toys."
- 2. For additional labeling clarity and consistency, please refer to the enclosed EPA reviews.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec.6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage and/or skin burns. Maybe fatal if inhaled, Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Do not breathe spray mist. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going to treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use by manufacturers only as an antimicrobial treatment. For the control of mildew, odor causing bacteria and fungi that may affect the integrity of the treated textiles used in the manufacture of mattress tickings. Also as a microbiostat preservative for the following aqueous compositions: latices, non-food contact adhesives, casein/rosin dispersions which are then used in the manufacture of carpet underlays, carpet backing and upholstery undersides.

DILUTION RATE AND APPLICATION

Use 1.0 to 2.0 % of the Sanitized TB 83-35 product per 1000 gallons.

Mattress Ticking:

Use a concentration of 1.0 to 2.0% of the Sanitized TB 83-35 product, relative to the dry weight of the fabric/textile/material being treated.

Latices: (polymers, synthetic, rubber)

Use a concentration of 0.3 to 1.5 % of the Sanitized TB 83-35 product, relative to the total weight of the material being treated.


Adhesives: (NON-FOOD CONTACT)

Use a concentration of 0.3 to 1.5 % of the Sanitized TB 83-35 product, relative to the total weight of the material being treated.

Casein/Resin:

Use a concentration of 0.3 to 1.5 % of the Sanitized TB 83-35 product, relative to the total weight of the material being treated.
