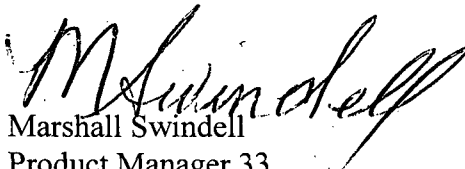

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT - FIRST AID
