3. Revise the Storage Statement to read:


Storage: Store in original container away from food and feedstuffs. Keep product in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets.

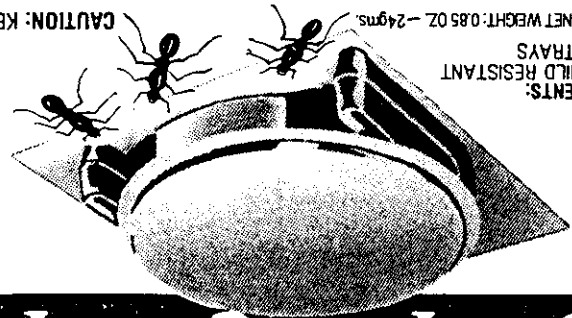

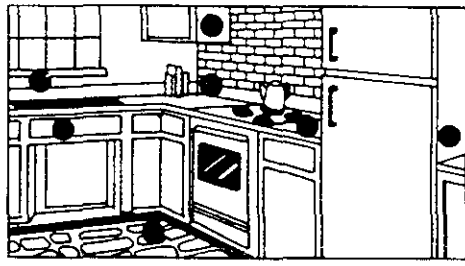

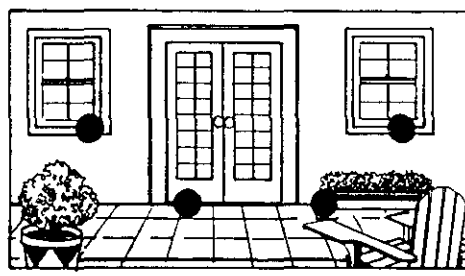

PIC ANT CONTROL SYSTEMS® has been the effective method for destroying ants for years. The bait is in four child resistant containers. It is effective and easy to use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Separate Bait Trays.
2. Remove all sources of food such as crumbs, sugar, and grease spots.
3. Place under sinks—refrigerator—cupboard.
4. Place by ant trails where ants are numerous.
5. For Garden & Lawn: Place along trails & ant colonies. Put traps 10-20 ft. apart.

In 3-7 days ants will be killed. Replace with new traps every 30 days. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENT:

STORAGE—Store container in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL—Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

CAUTION—Keep out of reach of children & domestic animals.

HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS:

The ants you see are worker food providers to the Queen Mother and the larvae residing in the nest. The worker ants feed the colony and then themselves. Thus, the entire colony is destroyed.
