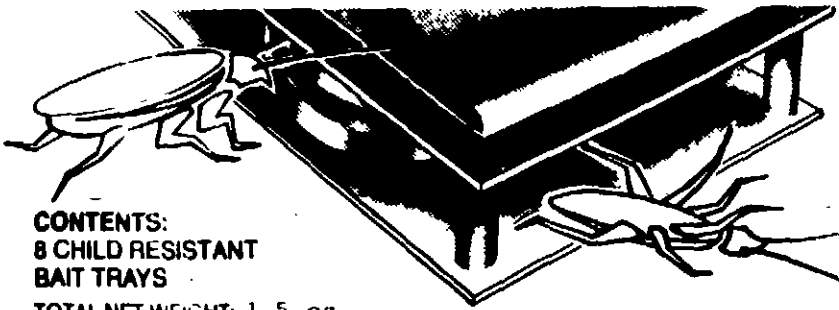

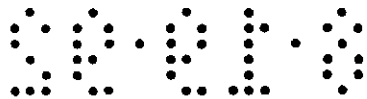

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- Do not use in violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.
- Do not remove from box till ready to use
- Prior to using Remove all sources of food such as crumbs, sugar, grease spots
- Remove Bait Trays from plastic frame
- For effective roach control - Use all 12 Bait Trays at one time

This large station is especially designed for large roaches, palmetto bugs and large water bugs. Large bugs usually live outdoors and enter the home seeking water and food. Thus, placement should be near possible home entry points - doors, large doors, and porches. The smaller type roaches are usually found in bedrooms, pantries, and kitchens, especially near water pipes and refrigerators. After using for 7 to 10 days, the roach population will decrease - replace the traps every 2-3 months for continued effective control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENT:

- STORAGE - Store in area inaccessible to children
- DISPOSAL - Wrap trays and put in trash can

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED:

- Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs. Do not use product in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is prepared or processed. Do not remove Bait from trays

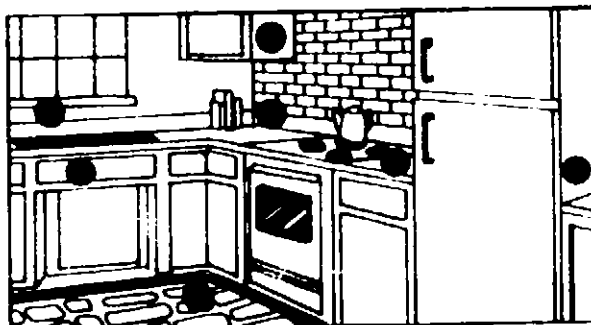
