- 1) Change the ingredient statement to read:

**Active Ingredients:**

N,N-diethyl-m-toluamide . . . . . 95%  
Other isomers . . . . . 5%

- 2) Change the signal word "Caution" to "Warning" wherever is appears on the label.
- 3) Add the following precautionary statements to the label:


"May cause eye injury. Harmful if swallowed"

- 4) Add the following Statement of Practical Treatment:

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists get medical treatment.  
If Inhaled: Call a physician or poison control center. Get medical attention.
