PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a Poison Control Center for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or Doctor or going for treatment.

Directions for Use (Shake Well Before Using)

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray away from person. Push button to spray.

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, YELLOW JACKETS: POINT VALVE OPENING TOWARD NEST, CREVICE OR HOLE WHERE INFESTATION OR INSECTS ARE KNOWN TO BE INSIDE. DEPRESS BUTTON, CONTINUING TO SPRAY UNTIL THE NEST OR THE AREA SPRAYED IS COMPLETELY SATURATED. APPLICATION AT NIGHT AFTER THE INSECTS HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR NEST IS PREFERABLE. REPEAT AS NECESSARY. A SPRAY FROM 16 FEET OR MORE AWAY DIRECTED INTO NESTS, CREVICES, HOLES WILL KILL WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, YELLOW JACKETS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
