CAUTION

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpet should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, area under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.
