The confidential statement of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated January 10, 1997) has been added to the product file and supersedes all previously-submitted confidential statements of formula for the basic formulation.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Due to the change in the confidential statement of formula, revise the Ingredients Statement to read as follows:

ACTIVE INGREDIENT	
Sodium tetraborate pentahydrate.....	5.0%
INERT INGREDIENTS.....	95.0%
TOTAL.....	100.0%

2. The net contents statement must be expressed in ounces. Use of the metric measurements is also acceptable, however they should appear in parentheses.


3. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

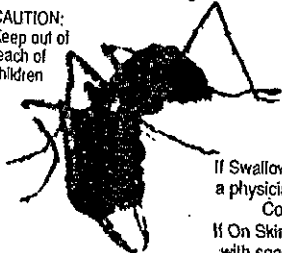

Place a few drops along the ant trails and a small amount in cracks and crevices where ants are visible. The ants will take bait to their nests for feeding the larvae, queen ant, and themselves. In about 7-10 days, the entire colony will be destroyed.

CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO AVOID DEPOSITING THE PRODUCT OVER EXPOSED SURFACES. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FOOD OR FOOD PROCESSING SURFACES OR SURFACES LIKELY TO BE CONTACTED BY FOOD.

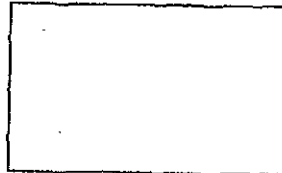
