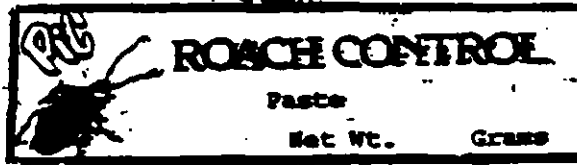

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove cap at tip of barrel of the pre-filled, disposable syringe or the tube applicator then apply paste into cracks and crevices only in areas not easily accessible to children and pets. Keep exposed paste from food contact, surfaces and open food.

Use Pic Roach Paste as a spot or crack and crevice treatment for control of cockroaches in and around homes; non food areas of institutions, warehousing and commercial buildings; telephone facilities, sewers, garbage areas, on buses, trains, planes and ships. Apply paste near aggregation and harboring areas. Use under surface of counters, tables, shelving, drawers, under sinks, around pipe collars, under refrigerators, stoves, electrical boxes and computer housing. Keep record of area to which applied. Reapply in 1 - 2 weeks if no bait is visible. Use a number of smaller spot applications for quicker control rather than a few large spots.
