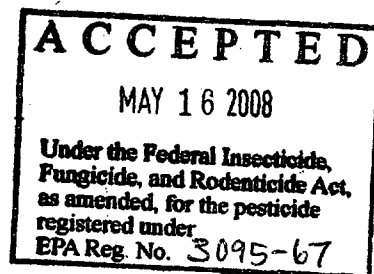

This is the plunger hooking onto the clear piston. Remove the Protective end cap (C), slowly push in the plunger to release paste contents.
