Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.


2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

CHEMONITE PART B - PRODUCT BULLETIN

CHEMONITE PART B is a component of Chemonite wood preservatives for pressure treatment. When mixed in accordance with the detailed instructions provided by J. H. Baxter & Co., Chemonite wood preservatives conform with AWPA specifications.

-RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

CHEMONITE PART B is cement copper. It is intended to be mixed with other components to formulate Chemonite wood preservative solutions for use in pressure treatment.

J. H. Baxter & Co. mixing instructions must be followed carefully to ensure that the treatment solution conforms with AWPA specifications.

Further information and assistance in solving particular problems is available from our technical staff.

USE PRECAUTIONS

The following precautions should be observed in handling and using CHEMONITE PART B.

CHEMONITE PART B causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after use.

Do not contaminate lakes, streams or ponds, by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. Do not reuse empty container. Container should be triple rinsed (or equivalent) and offered for recycling or reconditioning, or disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

To avoid contact with eyes, wear goggles where exposure to CHEMONITE PART B is likely.

FIRST AID PROCEDURES

In case of contact, immediately flush skin or eyes with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.
