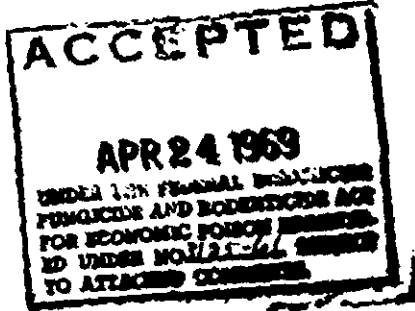

Sorghum	Aphids	12 ounces per 1000 ft. of row (for any row spacing*) or 10 pounds per acre (40 inch row spacing)	Apply specified dosage by broadcasting into the whorl. Do not apply more than once per crop season nor within 30 days of harvest for grain or 14 days of harvest for forage and fodder.

*ON ROW CROPS WHERE ROW SPACING IS EXTREMELY NARROW, DO NOT PLACE TREATED ZONES (BAND OR FURROW) CLOSER TOGETHER THAN 6 INCHES.
