Soybeans	Thrips (except flower thrips) Mexican bean beetle	11 ounces per 1000 feet of row (for any row spacing*) or 10 pounds per acre (36 inch row spacing)	Place the granules in a 4-inch band over the seed furrow behind the planter shoe and in front of the press wheel or in a band on each side of the seed furrow at planting time. Do not apply directly on the seed.

*On row crops where row spacing is extremely narrow, do not place treated zones (band or furrow) closer together than 6 inches.
