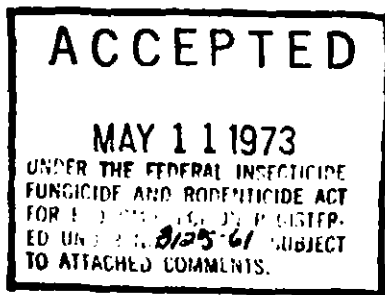

*ON ROW CROPS WHERE ROW SPACING IS EXTREMELY NARROW, DO NOT PLACE TREATED ZONES (BAND OR FURROW) CLOSER TOGETHER THAN 6 INCHES.
