The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

1. Since a dosage range is given for all uses, include a general statement indicating when to use the high and low rates.
2. The statement "equivalent . . ." on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) submitted is not acceptable because EPA must determine if the chemicals are equivalent especially in cases when you are not privileged to the complete composition of the product. The inert products and the active ingredient names, addresses, and composition must be specific and the CSF must be updated each time a product or supplier changes.
3. The label claim must correspond to the lower certified limit.
4. Also, if you are intending to use Mobay's 80% dry concentrate as the active ingredient source for the alternate CSF you must indicate the EPA Registration Number.

If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.
