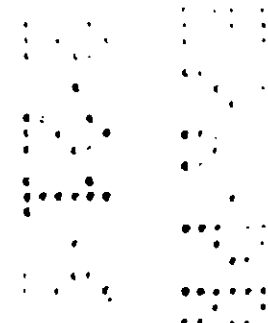

For best results, mow the lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After the granules are uniformly applied, water the lawn using 15 to 30 gallons per 1,000 square feet. Do not water again for at least three days. Repeat applications as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas the first of these applications should be made in May or June. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service Specialists for more specific information regarding timing of applications.

RESTRICTIONS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (Continued)

CAUTION

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 ml) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. If on skin, wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children.

Should poisoning occur, obtain prompt medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression.

TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
