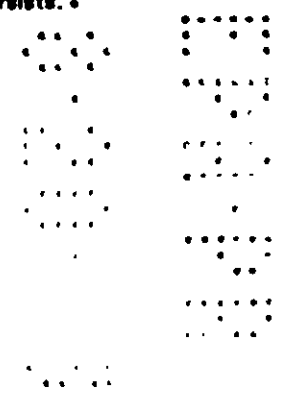
STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
