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Subject: Dyrene 3% Granular Turf Fungicide EPA Registration No. 3125-107 Your Submission Dated April 28, 1986

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

- 1. Revise the claim to control "leaf spot" by indicating the leaf spot disease or diseases intended.
- 2. Add "Do not graze treated areas. Do not feed clippings to livestock" under the Directions for Use.
- 3. Add a statement indicating when to use the high and low rates of the dosage range.

The statement "equivalent . . ." on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) submitted is not acceptable because EPA must determine if the chemicals are equivalent especially in cases when you are not privileged to the complete composition of the product. The inert products and the active ingredient names, addresses, and composition must be specific and the CSF must be updated each time a product or supplier changes.

The label claim must correspond to the lower certified limit.

Also, if you are intending to use Nobay's 80% dry concentrate as the active ingredient source for the alternate CSF you must indicate the EPA Registration Number.

DYRENE 3% Granular turf fungicide effectively protects grasses from various destructive diseases. Uniform distribution of granular material is necessary for maximum control. For a preventive program begin applications before diseases appear and repeat treatments as needed, usually at intervals of 10 to 14 days, except during extended periods of cool, moist conditions, when applicatins every 7 days may be advisable. Applications should be continued through the spring and summer months.

For control of Typhula snow mold, apply DYRENE 3% Granular at lower specified rate after the first killing frost in the fall. A second application should be made when the lawn is free of snow in mid-winter, and this should be followed by a third application after the final melting of snow in late winter or early spring.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Household: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection.

Pesticide Disposal (Except Household): Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal (Except Household): Do not use container in connection with food, feed, or drinking water. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing of dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

Protective clothing should be worn during periods of NOTE: exposure, such as during application, or when contacting treated foliage. DYRENE may cause an allergic skin reaction in some susceptible persons. This condition should be treated as an allergic dermatitis.

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STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If on skin, wash immediately with soap and warm water. If irritation occurs, get medicat attention.

If swallowed, administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2.oz. or 15 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking inger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to

an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Cover or incorporate spills.

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
